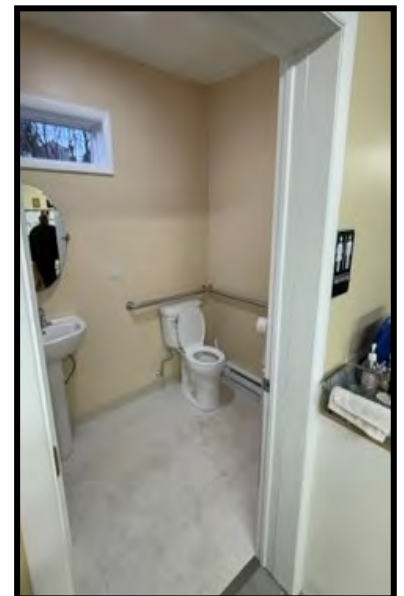
Our Mission
