

GREETINGS LIONS IN 14-L,

I KNOW OUR CLUBS ARE BUSY CURRENTLY AND WISH EVERYONE A HAPPY HOLIDAY SEASON WITH SUCCESSFUL SERVICE AND FUND-RAISING PROJECTS.

AS YOUR 2ND VICE DISTRICT GOVERNOR, I AM SPEARHEADING CLUB MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT WITH OUR DISTRICT ZONE CHAIRS. WITH MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS DECLINING ACROSS OUR DISTRICT, WE MUST TAKE MEMBER RECRUITMENT SERIOUSLY. IN MY NOVEMBER MESSAGE I EMPHASIZED THE IMPORTANCE OF ADVERTISING AND HOW IT CAN DRAW NEW MEMBERS TO YOUR CLUBS IF A MULTI-MODE ADVERTISING PROGRAM IS PUT INTO PRACTICE.

THE NEXT STEP, EQUALLY OR MORE IMPORTANT, IS PROPER ORIENTATION OF NEW MEMBERS WHICH SHOULD BEGIN SHORTLY AFTER A "NEW MEMBER INDUCTION CEREMONY". A NEW MEMBER MUST BE PRESENTED WITH THE LCI HISTORY, CLUB HISTORY, CLUB PROJECTS OLD AND ONGOING THAT WERE SUCCESSFUL AND THE IMPACT IT HAS ON THE LOCAL COMMUNITY. LCI NEW MEMBER ORIENTATION PACKETS ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE DISTRICT OR THE LCI WEBSITE AND ARE FREE TO ALL CLUBS.

SECONDLY, CLUBS NEED TO ASSESS A NEW MEMBER'S LIKES, DISLIKES, AND WORK SKILLS BY ADMINISTERING A NEW MEMBER QUESTIONNAIRE. THE QUESTIONNAIRE FOUND IN THE LCI BROCHURE "JUST ASK" WILL IDENTIFY ROLES OR TASKS THAT NEW MEMBERS WILL BE COMFORTABLE TO PERFORM.


